

# The Sweet-Jayne and Related Families of Michigan

Celina Sweet-Vert-Salvador

DIED ON MAY 17th 1865  
at Age One-Hundred

At the residence on Lot #32, 7th Conc. London Twp., on Wednesday last the 10th of May, Mr. Joseph Jayne, age 100 yrs, 10 months, and 27 days, having been born on Long Island, N.Y. on June 13th, 1764, some years before the state of New York ceased to be a British Province.

Full of years not unkept or unhonored has passed away in the possession of his faculties, mental and otherwise, the last in all human probability of a generation whose representatives of note, having long since "fretted their hour on the stage" having all crumbled into the dust and left as a link between the past and the present age the humble contemporary whose death is now recorded.

Still though he passed a life of almost primitive simplicity in the far off wilds of Canada, his death recalls to mind thoughts, the events of a hundred years which have passed into history since this veteran of an -other age first saw the light. The date of his birth is recorded in the early military rolls of Canada, an authentic certificate having been procured a few years ago from the Adjent General's Department, but had such testimony been wanting, conversations which the writer has always had the pleasure of holding with this man relative to the events which his memory had wonderfully preserved, and with which he could speak with much clearness of comprehension, would almost of themselves have fixed the date of his birth.

At the time George Washington was but 23 years old. Ben Franklin was scarcely past the prime of life, and that "little cloud no bigger then a mans hand" which subsequently spread over the provinces and transformed them into the United States of America", had just appeared on the political horizon, in the form of the famous debate in the Lords and Commons "whether they had a right to tax America", during the administration of Mr.

Grandville "great in daring and little in views" as was said by a celebrated writer of that time. Strange as it is, also, to think that those mighty representative men of a past period of history, one of whom dazzled the world by his illustrious career for much more than half a century, the other for a full generation, Arthur Wellesley, and the Corsican Lieutenant of Artillery in the service of Republican France, were yet unknown when Joseph Jayne climbed the fences on his father's farm and made nutting expeditions into the woods of Long Island. When the second of the "four Georges" reined in England, the father of Mr. Jayne, a London citizen, a blacksmith by trade, emigrated to the province of New York in 1755, obtained land and settled at Flatbush, Long Island. He there settled and carried on his trade together with the business of a farmer, to which also he brought up his son, until the year 1799, when New York having finally accepted the Constitution of the United States, the family remaining loyal to the Crown moved into Canada and obtained a land grant at Richmond, in the county of Carlton, from whence at a rather advanced age, the late Mr. Jaynes with his children, came to and finally settled in the Township of London.

From Mr. Jayne the writer has heard many traditions of scenes whereof he was an actual spectator during the war of revolution. He well remembered and graphically described the commotion in Long Island on the memorable day of August, 1776, when as a historian of the period has said, "terror reigned at New York", and how with the farmers of Flatbush and Jamaica Plains and the people of the country, he went upon a hot summer day of the year, to see Sir Henry Clinton, Lord Cornwallis and Percy, Generals Grant and Sir William Msrkine, with 9,000 British troops, and 40 pieces of cannon, land the fleet anchored off Governor's Island under Lord Howe drive in General Green's skirmishers, and pitched their tents below Governors Heights, in which the people stood to see the operations of the armies, & from which they fled back into the county, as the fight thickened and the tide of battle rolled to the ground on which they stood, which on the evening of the same day that they landed (the British) was occupied by General DeKeister and his Hessians. The subsequent arrival of Washington in person, his retreat by night with the whole army across the Sound, his subsequent stand at White Plains, were all events which Mr. Jaynes could partly speak as an eye witness. He has described to the writer, how well he remembers the white smoke from the hostile cannon rising above the trees of Governor Heights. The appearance of Lord Howe's fleet as ship after ship passed up the Sound, firing into the enemy redoubts and shore batteries, and receiving their fire in return, and a few days later e booming of the Cannonade, from the White Plains reached the ears of the inmates of his father's house, as himself having had a distinct recollection of the day.

In the war of 1812 Joseph Jayne was a non-commissioned officer in one of the Militia regiments engaged in the operations about the head of the Saint Lawrence under General the De Rottenburgh, and was severely wounded in the head when with a party an officer of one of the King's regiments in charge of ammunition, during the attack upon Sackett's Harbor. His wound caused, for many years, total loss of memory, and partial derangement, from which however, he eventually recovered, and, as he himself expressed it; "when he came out of the trance" his mind and memory were stronger and fresher then before. He, however, then found himself forgotten in the awarding of pension's to the soldiers of the war. After several petitions to the executive, and many delays he was at length; by the Earl of Elgin, placed on the pension list for a special gratuity of 20 pounds per annum, in the receipt of which he continued until his death and this was obtained through the exertions of an honorable life member of the Legislative Council, a Gentleman who formerly represented London in the Lower House.

Mr. Jayne has left a widow, and daughter, and some sons who resided with and around him on their own farms.
